The layout of the Autism Guernsey offices may seem rather confusing, but please do not worry about getting a lost. A member of staff will always be there to explain where you need to go within the office area.

This is the main corridor.

You will see individual offices (doors may be open, or closed) and the kitchen area along this corridor.

Staff may be busy working or having meetings, so please do not go into any of the offices unless you are invited to do so.





Depending on which member of staff you are meeting with or the reason for your visit, you may go into the meeting room.

There are bright red chairs and a wooden table in this room.

If you need to use the **toilet** during your visit to our offices, you will need to go back through reception, through the door, and turn left.

There is a short corridor, and you will see two doors on your left. These have the standard toilet symbol signs on the doors.

(Please note these toilets are also used by other people who work in the building).

Please ask a member of Autism Guernsey's staff if you need assistance to find your way to the toilets.
